CORRECTIONS TO "ROSE MINIATURES" CATALOGUE AUTUMN 1965

Page 2, the 'A' List should read:- A 1 price a, A 4 price c, A 5 price g, A 6 price f, A 7 price e, and the Miniprint price code 1, i.e. 6 shillings.

Page 20, GER 6 Colour bearer should read for the painted model price code R, not P. The model to order for the Under Office Reg.170 is GER 11 not GER 1.

Page 22, the collar is marked as B 153 on the illustration, it should be B 152.

Page 26, the numbers have slipped down a line from the Uhlan with lance. They should read XX 115 Uhlan with lance, XX 117 Leib Garde Hussar, and XX 118 Garde du Corps Standard bearer.

Some confusion has been caused by the Miniprint price code, due to the typeface we are using which makes no distinction between the large and small ell. The Miniprint price code is the small ell, i.e. 6 shillings.

In order to make your catalogue as convenient as possible, correct all the above items on their appropriate pages in ink, and also make cross checks for the odd models overleaf. For instance the Greek model should be noted on page 4 as GRF 4 Girl with amphora (see page 42) and the BW 7Zc noted on page 24 in similar manner. If you do this you should be able to find the complete range of any period easily.

To add this sheet to your catalogue, slide the plastic binder off the back, insert after page 40, close, and shake the sheets level down in the fold. Using the rounded end of the binder, ease it on and slide across back.

With the exception of the Guides who have a sheepskin coat, all the arms for the Indians can be interchanged, so it is possible to have a pioneer with a Martini Henry rifle in the 'f' or 'm' position. The arms have the slashed cuffs or the pointed cuffs. If the plain rounded cuffs are required just file off the slash or piping of the pointed cuff.

The heads also can be interchanged, but a few have longer necks to fit the collarless tunics worn by some of the Regiments at this period.

Painting Instructions 127th. Q.M.O. Baluch L.I. Sepoy Turban dark green with red kulla. Kurta dark green, scarlet piping on chest panel, bottom of collar and round cuff point. Scarlet shoulder straps. Cummerbum a darkish rose colour, mix a little white with crimson and add a little scarlet for this. Trousers similar colour to cummerbum, but they need not be exactly the same as they would be of different materials. Gaiters white with brass buttons. Boots natural leather to black.

With these also are two new cast bases, similar in shape to the new large model bases, but with textured surface to represent terrain. These models are only sold as listed and the new bases are not suitable for older horses. PXX100 and PXX101 are sold complete with painting instructions.






THE NEW MODELS

We are confident that the collectors who prefer painting to assembling models will find the new single or two piece figures just what they have been looking for. We also hope the new method of numbering and classifying models will prove easier. The letters and figures were beginning to get out of hand and this simpler form should prove adequate to identify the figures and it will also indicate whether it is a single piece model i.e., with S as first letter, or two piece with T as the first letter. The use of a second letter E for English, S for Scottish, R for

Bachanian will prevent us reaching treble figures too soon.


Looking at the photographs you may well be surprised that such movement and variation is possible in a single casting. When you get your models we hope you will also notice that all detail is sharply cast with no flash and in most cases no parting line at all. This is the result of years of experience and an entirely new brush through in moulding technique, coupled with first class design - which after all is what you should be now expect from Rose Miniatures. If there is any doubt in your mind that we are not producing the best models available, then just take any of our present range and try and find its equal either as a casting or painted.
